The general condition of the Free Gardens allotments is excellent. The work done by Mr Roberts on the vacant allotments was also judged excellent.

Whether or not it is necessary to obtain planning permission to undercut the tree canopies in the Jubilee garden to facilitate mowing under those trees requires further discussion by the Trustees.

Due to complaints received from parishioners, the Trustees should consider organising the cutting of the rampant ivy growing on two trees on the Seagry Road boundary of the Free Gardens.
